

Tips for Exhibitors Regarding Cleanliness and COVID-19

- Don't shake hands.
- If you have something for people to fill out, fill it out for them to restrict the number of people touching a pen, iPad etc.
- If you use an iPad or phone for people to sign a credit card, have alcohol wipes handy to clean it off BEFORE each use, so that the attendees know it is clean.
- Have hand sanitizer available in your booth.
- Open "crash doors" (doors with push bars) with your back and not your hand.
- Do not refill water bottles at public stations. Bring a gallon (or more if you need it) with you each day and store it in your booth. Refill from your own dispenser.
- Clean everything and do it often. Anti-bacterial wipes and hand-sanitizer should be used when you are not able to wash your hands.
- When you wash your hands, lather all parts of your hands the palms, the backs, between your fingers, and under your nails. Lather up for a 20-second count (sing happy birthday or recite the ABC's each are roughly 20 seconds).
